THE MIRACLES OF JESUS CHRIST

Jesus did many miracles that were not recorded in scripture. John 21:25, 6:2

1. HE HAD POWER OVER CREATION

- A. John 2:1-11 This was the beginning of his signs.
 - I. Although Jesus didn't parade his divine glory around He did use his divine attributes to manifest his glory in order that people might believe in Him.
- B. He is the CREATOR! John 1:3, 10; Colossians 1: 16
- C. He is the SUSTAINER! Colossians 1:17; Hebrews 1:2-3
 - I. Laminin: cell adhesive molecule.
 - III. 2 Peter 3:10
 - -In a nuclear explosion things liquefy. They liquefy because something happens to their molecular structure: it is loosed from each other.
 - The elements will melt.
 - Until that happens Jesus holds everything together.
 Molecularly and structurally. Heb 1:3
- D. John 2:23
 - I. Many believed Intellectually that Jesus actually did these miracles yet they failed to put their faith and trust in Him as their savior.
- E. John 7:31, 9:16, 11:47, John 12:37, Acts 2:22
 - I. People understood that the Messiah would do miracles *Isaiah* 35:4-6
 - II. Even the religious leaders who did not believe in Him-who did not think he was the Messiah also recognized that He did many miracles.
- 2. HE HAD POWER OVER DISEASE John 4:46-54
 - A. Matthew 4:23-25
 - I. God still heals today. Heb. 13:8
 - -When God **in His graciousness and for His own purposes** heals people He desires the glory, honor and praise. He isn't just healing so that a person can be comfortable or well.
 - II. He can heal **every** kind of disease and sickness.
- 3 HE HAD POWER OVER BIRTH DEFECTS!
 - A. John 5:1-9
 - I. The man **had**...It doesn't say that it came upon him.
- 4. HE HAD POWER OVER FOOD SUPPLY!
 - A. John 6:1-15
 - I. They were ready to take Him by force and make Him a king V.15
 - II. God is the Jehova Jira- The God who provides. Gen 22:14

5. HE HAD POWER OVER NATURE!

- A. Luke 8:22-25
 - I. The wind and the seas obey Him
- B. John 6:16-21
 - I. He walked on the water.
- 6. HE HAD POWER OVER BLINDNESS!
 - A. Matthew 20:29-34
 - I. They called him "Son of David", They were acknowledging that he was the coming Messiah from the O.T.
 - II. Jesus was moved with compassion.

-splagchnizomai be moved as to one's bowels, hence to be moved with compassion, have compassion (for the bowels were thought to be the seat of love and pity)

- B. John 9:1-38
 - I. Some sickness does result from sinning, but some sickness is not the result of specific sinning, though all sickness is a result of original sin and depravity. 1 Cor. 11; 1 John 5:16

7. HE HAD POWER OVER DEATH!

- A. John 5:21, 25-29
 - I. Jesus gives life to whom he wishes. V.21
 - II. Everybody will be resurrected. All evil, wicked will be resurrected to stand before God at the Great White Throne Judgment
- B. John 11:1-4
 - I. The purpose of Lazarus illness was not to bring death but that illness which caused death was to bring glory to God.
 - II. Many People believed in his name John 11:45
