THE DIETY OF JESUS CHRIST #3

1A. HIS NAMES PROVES THAT HE IS GOD!

...

4B. He is called the "**LORD OF GLORY**"

A. Psa. 24:7-10 *"Lift up your heads, O gates, and be lifted up, O ancient doors, that the King of glory may come in! Who is the King of glory? The LORD strong and mighty, The LORD mighty in battle. Lift up your heads, O gates, and lift them up, O ancient doors, that the King of glory may come in! Who is the King of glory? The LORD of hosts, He is the King of glory."*

- YAHWEH is the King of glory
- The LORD of Hosts is the King of glory

B. 1 Corinthians 2:8 *"the wisdom which none of the rulers of this age has understood; for if they had understood it they would not have crucified the Lord of glory;"*

- Jesus was the one crucified!
- Anyone familiar with the O.T. would consider this proof that Paul believed Jesus was God.

5B. He is called the "**HOLY ONE**"

A. Isaiah 48:17 *"Thus says the LORD, your Redeemer, the Holy One of Israel, I am the LORD your God, who teaches you to profit, Who leads you in the way you should go."*

- Here the LORD (YAHWEH) is the Redeemer, the Holy One and God.

B. Acts 3:14 *"But ye denied the Holy One and the Just, and desired a murderer to be granted unto you;"*

- The passage is clearly speaking of Christ as the Holy One.
- Jews believe the Holy One to be Yahweh
- Here Peter, a Jew is giving pretty strong evidence that Christ is God.

6B. He is called "**THE FIRST AND THE LAST**"

A. Isaiah 44:6 *"Thus says the LORD, the King of Israel and his Redeemer, the LORD of Hosts: 'I am the first and I am the last, And there is no God besides me'"*

- The LORD (YAHWEH) is the King, Redeemer and also YAHWEH of Hosts who claim to be the first and the last.

B. Isaiah 41:4 *"Who has performed and accomplished it, calling forth the generations from the beginning? I, the LORD, am the first, and with the last, I am He."*

- Again YAHWEH is the first and the last.
- Duet. 6:4 YAHWEH is also God/Elohim. (The LORD is GOD)
 1. The LORD is one! The word "one" in Hebrew is "Echad" which means a plural one.

C. Rev.1: 17-18 *"When I saw Him, I fell at His feet like a dead man. And He placed His right hand on me, saying, 'do not be afraid; I am the first and the last, and the living One; and I was dead, and behold, I am alive forevermore, and I have the keys of death and of Hades."*

- This passage is clearly Jesus speaking and claiming to be the first and the last. (see also Rev. 1:8, Rev. 2:8)

D. Rev. 22:12 *"Behold, I am coming quickly, and My reward is with Me, to render to every man according to what he has done. I am the Alpha and the Omega, the first and the last, the beginning and the end."*

- Alpha is the first letter of the Greek alphabet and Omega is the last.
- Verse 16 confirms that Jesus is speaking!
- Rev. 19:13 Since He is the first letter and the last, and is the Word of God there is nothing left to say"

7B. He is called the "**LORD OF HOSTS**"

A. Isaiah 44:6 *"Thus says the LORD, the King of Israel and his Redeemer, the LORD of hosts: 'I am the First and the last, And there is no God besides Me"*

- Isaiah 44:6 He is the Redeemer
- Isaiah 6:3,5 He is the King
